A long time ago a man named Paul gave some advice to a young man named Timothy. He told him to: "Fan into a flame the gift of God, which is in you (II Timothy 1:6)." The fire inside young Timothy can be yours. But like a fire it has to be built. The Story of Fire is built upon a complex worldview that can be put Into simple words. Here are the words we use.

- The Story of God: God is real (Exodus 3:14).
- The Story of You: God created me (Genesis 1:27)
- o The Story of Faith: God loves me (John 3:16)
- The Story Worth Sharing: God loves everyone (II Corinthians 5:20)

The Story of Fire will never grow unless it is built upon these truths! But it will also die out unless it is properly cared for and fueled. What good is a fire that goes out? Does it serve any purpose? Does it provide any light or warmth? In a letter to a bunch of church people, an ex-fisherman named Peter warned that even churches built on the right truth could find themselves "ineffective and unproductive"... almost like a dying fire.

Thankfully Peter gave a list of things that could properly fuel the fire to keep it from burning out.

"Make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self control; and to self control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love. For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ (II Peter 1:5-8)."

The Story of Fire is built on Biblical truth and fueled by authentically embracing truth in a life changing way. At every phase of its story, fire must be nurtured, encouraged, and protected. At Hamlin Baptist Church we are committed to loving and leading your child through every chapter of this story. We never want their fire to die out. We want to fan it into a flame. We want it to grow. If it doesn't we will never fulfill our Mission: BUILD the FIRE in which the next generation can be FORGED in the love of God and REFINED by the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
